(2) This MOU is particularly for jointly conducting our Globally Collaborative Environment Peace Gaming (GCEPG), as making the Polytechnic as the leading institution of this project.

(3) I was very happy to know that President Hultin is strongly and enthusiastically willing to support this GCEPG, since he has done following so-called "War Games" with the Department of Homeland Security, port authorities of New Jersey and New York and more than 120 participants;

BTW, the purpose of the War Game is to win the war once it happened, and the purpose of the Peace Gaming is to avoid the occurrence of the war. I coined the word "Peace Gaming" in early 1970s.

President Hultin was the Dean of the Weseley J. Howe School of Technology Management at Stevens Institute of Technology in Hoboken, NJ, before he became the President of Polytechnic University. From 1997 to 2000, he served as Under Secretary of the Navy. He led an extensive study of the impact of globalization on national security and naval forces conducted by the National Defense University, as resulting into two-volume report "The Global Century: Globalization and National Security." He was a classmate of former President Bill Clinton at Yale University Law School.
