Guidelines for Contributors

Articles must be written in English Language. Articles should not exceed 18 pages (of MS Word), and should be on A4 size paper, double-line spaced, Times New Roman, font 12 size. Abstracts should not exceed 250 words.

References should follow the American Psychological Association (APA) format and should include all materials cited in the text. Footnotes are not acceptable. Visit <http://www.apa.org/journals/webref.html> ; <http://library.osu.edu/sites/guides/apagd.php>

Tables and figures should be cut down to the barest minimum required for effective communication of findings. They should be numbered consecutively and captioned.

The appropriate positions for inserting such tables/figures should be indicated in the text while the tables/figures should be attached to the end of the script. Figures must be of high quality, either professionally rendered or computer generated. All tables/figures must be cited in the text.

To facilitate blind review, a separate title page containing the author(s)' name(s), their institutional affiliations, postal, official and e-mail addresses, telephone and fax numbers of individuals serving as the point of contact should be provided.

Papers will be accepted on the clear understanding that no substantial part has or will be published elsewhere, and that they remain the copyright of the TIJEED. Authors are also expected to obtain permission to use extracts from previously published material(s) in their work.

Submit manuscripts as e-mail attachment as well as hard copy to the Editorial Office. A manuscript number will be mailed to the corresponding author within a week. All further correspondence may kindly be directed to the Editor-in-Chief.
