



Guide to Navigating the T21-Ghana Model

A. Introduction

The Threshold 21 (T21) Ghana is an analytical tool for strategy development and policy analysis. It integrates economic, social, and environmental considerations into a single, transparent computer model.

B. System Requirements

- System requirements necessary
 - PC format
 - 10MB of hard disk space
 - 32MB RAM
 - Windows 95 or later

C. Installation Instructions

- With the CD in your drive, go to Start and then Run
- Enter the CDrom drive label (default is usually D)
- When you see T21-Ghana file, click twice on that file name
- You will be led through the Installation, License Agreement, and Registration processes
- Target Directory – Here is where you indicate where the model will reside (the default is usually c:\Program Files\venapp). It is important to remember *where* you install the model.
- Program Menu Choice - Choose where you'd like the model icon to reside (a common place is Accessories)

D. Installing and launching the model

- Install the model (see instructions above)
- To launch the model, click on the Start Menu, select Programs, select Accessories (if that's where you saved it), and click the icon that displays T21Cape Verde
- The model will open and you will be ready to navigate the main menu

E. Main Menu

The main menu offers the following options:

1. Acknowledgments: contains the acknowledgements for this version of T21
2. Model structure: allows the user to investigate the structure of the model
3. About T21 data: describes the major data requirements and sources
4. Baseline simulation and Historical data: compares the base simulation run with historical data for major indicators
5. "What if..." simulation: allows the user to run a custom simulation and observe the impact of the MDG interventions on the system
6. View results of existing scenarios: displays a variety of indicators to monitor the impact of the MDG interventions on the system
7. Exit the model: exits the T21 application
